What's happening in Class

In reading, we've been learning about a few different Native American tribes, and looking for similarities and differences. We continue to work on **comprehension, fluency, and decoding** in small groups, and work together to find **evidence** in the text to support our reasoning. Our **Writing**, unit on **Informational pieces** is coming to an end. We'll be working on **persuasive** writing next. In **Math**, we're finishing up our unit on **measurement**. We did a couple rounds of **metric and customary Olympics** to help kids with conversions. We took a practice test today to help study for next week's unit test. In **Social Studies**, our unit on **economics** is coming to a close. We spent some time today reviewing for the assessment next week. Our next unit will be on our system of **Government**. Kids will use what they're learning to complete their country project. We'll finish the year with a couple of **Science** units on **Moon Phases** and **Energy Transfer**.
